

SOUTH PACIFIC ODYSSEY

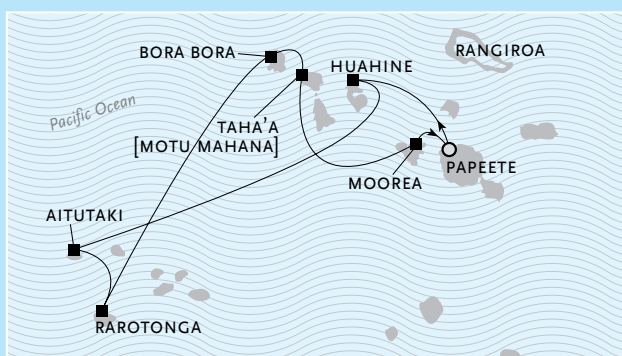
